Sustainable Grenadines Inc (SusGren). is a transboundary organization, registered both in St. Vincent and Grenada. SusGren is committed to the conservation of the coastal and marine environment and sustainable livelihoods for the people of the Grenadines.

This is being approached through capacity building and increased awareness of the environment for non-governmental organizations and community groups. In this regard, SusGren has received funding from the Caribbean Biodiversity Fund (CBF) through the German Development Bank (KfW) for a project entitled “*To Scale-Up Restoration at Ashton Lagoon for Climate Change Adaptation and Sustainable Livelihoods on Union Island*”.

Thus, it intends to use part of the funding towards architectural design for the expansion of the honey and greenhouse facility at Ashton Lagoon, Union Island.

The aim of the greenhouse facility is to ensure there is a constant supply of mature mangrove seedlings and other coastal plants that can be available on a rotating basis for restoration opportunities at Ashton Lagoon and other sites.

- The greenhouse is expected to house a capacity of 250 plants with approximately 500 sq./ft.
- The honey facility will be expanded using the foundation of the water cistern which already exists.

Interested individuals must have experience in designing similar projects in small communities with at least three successfully completed assignments during the past 3-5 years. Interested individuals must demonstrate sensitivity for ecological environments such as coastal areas, mangrove forest, bird habitats and bees.
