Request for Expression of Interest

Contractor – Installation of Revetment and Swale System at Ashton Lagoon

Sustainable Grenadines Inc (SusGren). is a transboundary organization, registered both in St. Vincent and Grenada. SusGren is committed to the conservation of the coastal and marine environment and sustainable livelihoods for the people of the Grenadines.

This is being approached through capacity building and increased awareness of the environment for non-governmental organizations and community groups. In this regard, SusGren has received funding from the Caribbean Biodiversity Fund (CBF) through the German Development Bank (KfW) for a project entitled “*To Scale-Up Restoration at Ashton Lagoon for Climate Change Adaptation and Sustainable Livelihoods on Union Island*”.

Thus, it intends to use part of the funding towards hiring a contractor with the relevant qualifications and expertise to install a bioengineered revetment and swale system at Ashton Lagoon, Union Island. The aim of the revetment is to minimise erosion occurring in the vicinity of the first over the water at Ashton Lagoon and also to install a swale system to allow for increase oxygenated water in and out of the mangrove forest that is experiencing “die-back”. This will include the overall works to be done;

- The revetment will be approximately 100ft x 3ft x 8ft that will be enforced by geofabric, armor rock
- The swale system will be approximately 40ft x 4ft
- Install a wooden bridge over the swale system with a specification of approximately 8ft x 6ft x 4ft

Interested individuals must have experience in designing similar projects in small communities with at least three successfully completed assignments during the past 3-5 years. Interested individuals must demonstrate sensitivity for ecological environments such as coastal areas, mangrove forest, bird habitats and bees.
